Winemaking



Wine ageing: 14 months in french oak barrels: 15% new 85% used (2, 3 and 4 uses) and 5 months in 5.200L french wooden vats.

Process: Selection of the best vineyards from the 25 terroirs of the Atauta Valley. Production by terroir in wooden vats and concrete tanks, selecting the material according to the characteristics of the grapes in each terroir.

Tasting notes



Dominio de Atauta 2021 is complex, balanced and fresh. Bright cherry colour with hints of violet. Clean aroma, very intense and complex, of red and black fruits accompanied with aromas of aromatic herbs that mix perfectly with a mineral background of chalk from the chalky rock on which the Atauta Valley sits. It maintains the freshest and most elegant style, faithfully expressing the personality of the Atauta Valley.

Vineyards

Soils: Sandy clay loam that lies over a layer of calcareous rock which is between 0,8 and 1,7 meters deep

Alt. from sea level: From 940m on the valley floor to 1010m in the moorland areas.

Average age: 100% prephyllloxeric vines from 120 to 140 years old

Climate: Extreme continental climate with Mediterranean characteristics, noted for its long and cold winters and short and hot summers.
